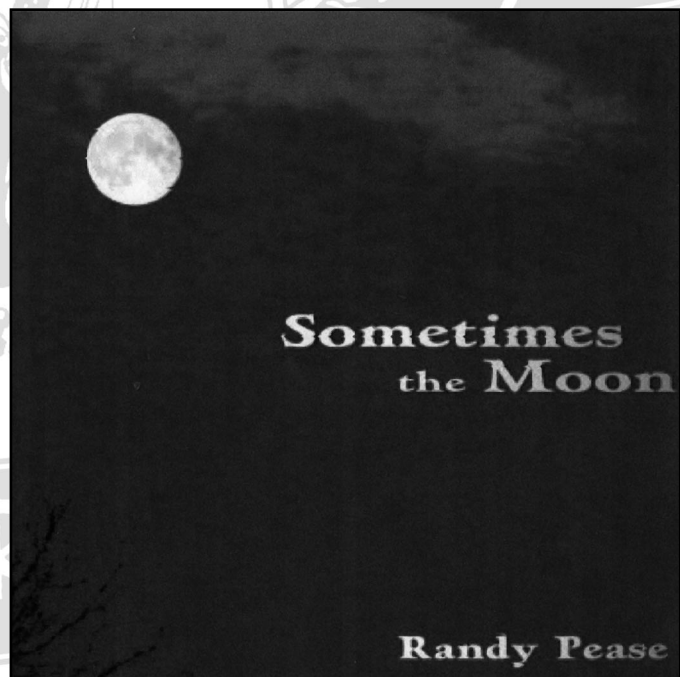

THE ARTIST: Randy Pease is an integral part of the Oklahoma "red dirt" music scene, along with friends Jimmy Lafave, Bob Childers, Greg Jacobs, Tom Skinner, the Red Dirt Rangers, and Cross Canadian Ragweed. Rock critic Dave Marsh once said of Pease, "Imagine Loudon Wainwright with a better reading list". His songs are both literate and melodic, as attested to by the numerous cover versions turned in by other red dirt artists over the past few years.

THE RECORD: Sometimes The Moon contains 12 original songs. The record is produced by Jeff Parker whose credits include recent major label signing Cross Canadian Ragweed. Baseball fans will appreciate the bonus track, a demo version of "I Love This Game" (the best baseball tune this side of Chuck Brodsky).

MARKETING: Sometimes The Moon is targeted toward the Americana, Folk, and Roots markets. The CD is being supported with a long term print campaign including No Depression, Dirty Linen, and Sing Out magazines. Sometimes the Moon will be serviced to public radio and non-commercial country (Americana) stations.
